



**ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPTER 11.5  
OF THE FORSYTH COUNTY CODE ENTITLED  
"LIBRARY SYSTEM"  
(FORSYTH COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE)**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that Chapter 11.5 of the Forsyth County Code, entitled, "Library System" consisting of Sections 11.5-1 through 11.5-13, is hereby revised as shown in the attached Sections 11.5-1 through 11.5-13.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance shall become effective upon final adoption.

### ARTICLE I. - IN GENERAL

### ARTICLE II. - BOARD OF TRUSTEES†

Sec. 11.5-11. - Membership; terms; appointment; etc.

- (a) The Forsyth County Library System Board of Trustees shall consist of seven (7) members.
- (b) Members shall serve for terms of three (3) years from the date of appointment and until their successors are appointed and qualified; provided, one (1) member of the Board of Commissioners shall serve ex officio as a member of the library board for the duration of his or her term of office as a Commissioner, with full rights, duties, and responsibilities as other library board members.
- (c) Appointments and vacancies shall be filled by the Board of Commissioners of Forsyth County.
- (d) The library board shall elect a chairman and such other officers as deemed advisable.
- (e) The Board of Commissioners may remove a trustee at any time for incapacity, unfitness, misconduct, or neglect of duty.
- (f) Members shall serve without compensation.

Sec. 11.5-12. - Duties.

The board of trustees of the Forsyth County Library System shall advise the Board of Commissioners on library matters and make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners.

Sec. 11.5-13. - Operation.

The Forsyth County Library System shall be operated in accordance with Article 14 of Chapter 153A of the North Carolina General Statutes.
